CA freight strategies are effective


Change in cancer risk since 2005:



- Increase economic competitiveness
















Concepts to Reduce the Community Health Impacts from Large Freight Facilities


Existing measures are effective, more reductions are needed

- Board consideration on September 27



Examples of ZE Operations Demonstrations and Incentives

- Installation of 37 shore power berths
 - Ports of Oakland, Long Beach, Los Angeles and Hueneme
- Port of Los Angeles Green Omni Terminal
 - At berth vessel emissions capture & control system demo: Shore-Kat
- Zero-Emission hydrogen ferry demonstration in Bay Area
- Retrofit tugboat with a hybrid propulsion system
