Federal Fall Deadlines

- September 15th: House deadline to draft Reconciliation Package
- September 27th: IIJA and Reconciliation Package vote in the House
- September 30th: Multiple expirations
 - oEnd of FY21/Start of FY22
 - **OFAST Act**
 - National Flood Insurance Program
- Sometime in October: Debt ceiling



Build Back Better Agenda

Two primary components of the President's Build Back Better Agenda:

- American Jobs Plan
 - Traditional infrastructure
 - Roads, bridges, waterways and broadband
- American Families Plan
 - Care giver economy
 - Early childhood education, childcare, community college



Infrastructure Package Development

- July 1, 2020: House passed H.R. 2 the Moving Forward Act 233-188
- March 31, 2021: President Biden released the American Jobs Plan
- May Mid-June: Senator Capito (R-WV) offered a counter proposal
- Mid-June: Bi-partisan group of 21 senators and President Biden agreed to a framework
- August 10th: Senate passed Infrastructure Investment & Jobs Act (IIJA) 69-30
- September 27th: House vote expected



IIJA Funding Highlights

Funding primarily flows through competitive grant opportunities (DOT) or work plans (Corps):

- Port Infrastructure Development Program: \$2.25B
- Grants for Reduction of Truck Emissions at Port Facilities: \$150M
- Marine Highways Program: \$25M
- RAISE: \$7.5B
- INFRA: \$3.2B
- CRISI: \$5B
- NEW National Infrastructure Project Assistance: \$5B
- Corps: \$16.176B
- NOAA: \$50M for coastal, ocean and Great Lakes observing systems and \$150M for marine debris assessment, prevention, mitigation and removal and \$492M for National Oceans and Coastal Security



IIJA & Reconciliation

How IIJA & Reconciliation fit together:

- •Infrastructure Investment & Jobs Act
 - Traditional infrastructure totaling \$1.2T
 - OA subset of infrastructure proposed in the President's American Jobs Plan

Reconciliation

• The President's American Families plan PLUS infrastructure items from the American Jobs Plan that were not included in IIJA



Fiscal Year 2022 Appropriations Overview

- A return of earmarks
- 11 of 12 House bills cleared the House in late August
- Senate has marked up 3 of 12 bills in Full Committee. Two more could be considered week of September 20th
- Continuing Resolution(s) will be needed to avoid a government shutdown
- FY21 Omnibus passed by Congress 12/21/20 and signed by President 12/27/20

HOUSE

- **Total Funding** \$8.6B
- General Investigations (GI) \$155M
- Construction General (CG) \$2.6B
- Operation & Maintenance (O&M) -\$4.8B \$4.682B
- WIFIA (for non-federal dams) -\$5.7M
- Flood Control and Coastal Emergencies (FCCE)- \$35M
- Harbor Maintenance Trust Fund (HMT) - \$2.05B

SENATE

- **Total Funding** \$8.7B
- **General Investigations** (GI) \$153M
- Construction General (CG) \$3.002B
- Operation & Maintenance (O&M) -\$4.682B
- WIFIA (for non-federal dams) -\$5.7M
- Flood Control and Coastal Emergencies (FCCE)- \$35M
- Harbor Maintenance Trust Fund (HMT) - \$2.05B



Water Resources Development Act

- WRDA 2020 implementation guidance release any day now
- Senate WRDA 2022 kick off hearing held summer 2021
- House WRDA 2022 anticipate action in early 2022
- 2022 priorities climate, equity, natural or nature-based infrastructure
- ASA Nominee Mike Connor approved by Senate Armed Services & EPW, awaiting floor consideration



Next Steps

- FY22 Work Plan Engage with Corps District & Division now and schedule Congressional meetings November/early December
- FY23 President's Budget Engage with Congress & OMB now
- FY23 Earmark or Language Request Use the fall to plan and prioritize, submission due early 2022
- IIJA Competitive Grants Prepare for NOFOs late 2021/early 2022 for first round funding
