








Ocean Alliance to dominate trans-Pacific trade

industry been able to charge more over time to move a container from port A to port B? The answer is no. Mergers may have cut liner costs, but they've yet to provide pricing power.

Global growth in container volumes has picked up slightly in the second quarter of the year, with growth in the first quarter.




